# What is a Confident Faith Day?

OCCA runs evangelistic and apologetics training days for churches, parachurch ministries, young professionals, and other groups who are seeking to become more confident in their faith by hosting an open space where their questions can be met with an answer.

## What do they offer?

- **Tailored** training day for your church or organisation
- Lectures and training from credible speakers
- Meaningful and accessible content
- Dialogue about faith questions
- Opportunities to invite other churches along to benefit your wider community







# What does a Confident Faith Day typically look like?

While we have a suggested format and brand for these days, we are keen to tailor the day to meet the needs of your group. Ultimately, the day consists of a number of lecture sessions, Q&A panels, and the opportunity for some good conversation.

#### **Topics**

The topics below are simply examples of what our speakers specialise in. While not a comprehensive list, they should give you an idea of today's big questions.

**Classical apologetics** topics exploring the arguments and reasons for a biblical worldview and scriptural accuracy:

- 1. How does a loving God allow suffering?
- 2. Why should I trust the Bible?
- 3. Old Testament: difficult passages
- 4. What about other religions?
- 5. Extra-biblical sources for Jesus

Cultural, ethical, and existential questions exploring identity and meaning:

- 1. Is faith good for the world?
- 2. What is my purpose?
- 3. Gender, sexuality, and identity
- 4. Dealing with doubt
- 5. Abortion, euthanasia, and bioethics

#### Topics for **evangelism training**:

- 1. How to share your faith
- 2. Telling your story
- 3. A heart for the lost
- 4. Keeping mission at the heart of the local church

#### **Purpose**


The overarching day can be defined by your **key motivation**. What do you imagine is the purpose of the day? Perhaps you would like to:


- 1. Train up leaders in your church
- 2. Offer credible apologetics and reasons for belief
- 3. Teach your congregation how to share their faith
- 4. Welcome people of all backgrounds to explore Christianity

#### **Format and Structure**

Each session can be comprised of lecture time, group work, and Q&A – or all three. Typically, it's worked well to allocate approximately **1 hour for each session**.






#### **Pitch**

A simple metric might be:




#### Advertising

'Confident Faith Day' is just a template brand - though we are happy to use it or substitute it for a name of your choosing.

We can also help provide branded materials for the advertising and presentation of the event, such as posters, postcards, and Powerpoint slides.







#### Venue

Naturally, your church might be a great place to host your event! However, it might be worth thinking through **capacity** and **audience**.

Perhaps there is a local venue that could hold a number of people from local churches that you invite, or perhaps there is a more neutral setting to host your event if the main goal is outreach. Or, maybe a building that offers various breakout rooms is needed.

Each venue has pros and cons. It is worth thinking through what setting will help to facilitate the desired tone and atmosphere for your event.

#### **Costs**

OCCA recommends charging for the event to cater for your guests and to signify what they can expect - high quality material.

The typical cost for OCCA to run a Confident Faith Day would account for 2-3 OCCA speakers plus travel expenses (i.e., £250 per speaker). OCCA is a charity and can only run days like this thanks to the generosity of it's supporters. In light of this, we welcome any donations to help us to keep impacting lives through our events, trainings, and outreach. That said, we love to partner with churches and groups, so if finances are an issue, please do get in touch with us.

# How do you organise a Confident Faith Day?


